Ref: Circular No. Pension/2022/56259/16541 dated February 20, 2023

The Madras Fertilizers Employees Contributory Provident Fund Trust (MFLECPF Trust) with Establishment No. TN/MAS/7929 was formed in the year 1974 and has been granted exemption under section 17 of the Employees Provident Fund Act -1952 and are functioning as per the Provident fund rules approved by the Regional Provident fund Commissioner, Tamil Nadu vide approval No. C9/TN/7929/Regl/EXM dated March 31, 1975 duly updated from time to time.


The Establishment has been complying with the respective Trust Rules framed under CPF regulations and Provident Fund contribution of the members at 12% on actual salary have been deducted from their salaries and the same along with the Employer's contribution at 12% on the actual salaries have been credited to the member's Provident Fund account under respective rules of the Trust with effect from the inception of the Trust since 1974.

Inspection Charges are also being paid on actual salaries and the Trust accounts are being audited by EPFO from time to time and we have made compliance to all audit points in letter and spirit to implement the scheme effectively for all our employees. EPFO's audit team never raised an audit point regarding the permission under para 26(6) of EPF Scheme, 1952 as they were well aware that, the contributions are on actual salary, which is over and above the prescribed limit under the Act.

As per the EPFO approved rules of the Trust, the permission has already been granted to contribute on actual salary. Under these circumstances, the provisions of para 26(6) of the EPF Scheme, 1952 have been complied with by the Establishment.

As it is mandatory to upload document pertaining to permission under para 26(6) of EPF Scheme, 1952 while submitting the online joint option form for higher pension on or before May 03, 2023, it is requested to kindly acknowledge this letter so that, we would like to inform our employees to upload the acknowledged copy of this letter for permission under section 26(6) of the EPF Scheme, 1952 while submitting the online option and would request you to please consider and accept their options for higher pension accordingly.

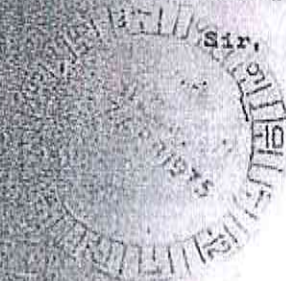
